From our experience only around 3% of staff remember their company's Mission Statement or Vision Statement.

Gaining team buy in to company strategy. This is over one **day plus pre meeting and both team & management follow up**. This session is ideally combined with your company's conference, with the launch of your New Year, financial or strategic plan, or before management have gone through strategic planning so they can build the strategy around the Vision.

Team Visioning is a one day team building event that offers management a chance to get the team's 'buy in' into the companies Strategic Plan, Mission Statement or Goals. We facilitate the team to create a better understanding of themselves, each other and where they see the team, company, competitors, market and customers in 6 or 12 months. This results in a Collective Collage built by the team to be kept in the team's work environment as a reminder of their goals. The team will then create an Action Plan for the next 6 months represented by the collage under the company umbrella.
